This award was presented during the Annual Leadership & Management Conference at the Marriott Griffin Gate during the Chairman's Luncheon. This award recognizes the Drivers, Safety Program, and Employees of Usher Transport, Inc. as being the "Top

Tank-Truck Carrier" for Fleet Safety in the State of Kentucky. Fleet Safety Excellence is only attainable through the efforts of <u>everyone</u>, our maintenance staff, billing, accounting, load planning, safety, and the senior leadership team.
